THE EDUCATION SIMULATION CENTRE

is now officially open at the Sturgeon Hospital, thanks to the support of our generous community of donors and supporters.

Ken Brisbin, Provincial Simulation Lead Program Planning, was on hand to introduce the media to the state-of-the-art training centre.

“We really took the needs of the hospital and learnings from other eSIM facilities across the province to create one of the most efficient simulation spaces I’ve helped build,” says Ken Brisbin, Simulation Lead - Planning, eSIM, AHS.

The newly opened \$1-million Clinical Simulation Centre features a high-tech, fully integrated space that can replicate a hospital room, operating room, and emergency department.

Healthcare teams at the Sturgeon Community Hospital now have a dedicated space to run simulated medical scenarios and sharpen their skills.

“Enhanced and effective healthcare delivery relies on teamwork and communication. This space will give healthcare practitioners at the Sturgeon the opportunity to practice realistic scenarios through guided facilitation and work together to achieve the best patient outcomes.”

The official opening of the eSIM was attended by Legacy Donors to the project as well as representatives from the Hospital: including, Site Director Karen Maeir, Medical Director Dr. Victoria Lee and Dr. Gabriel Suen, as well as key Foundation staff and Board members. We are so proud to have funded this new standard of excellence in healthcare simulation training in the province.

CELEBRATING LIVING LEGACY GIVING



// We are wanting to do what we can for the community. St. Albert gave us a future and a great quality of life and we are trying to do our little bit to make things stronger. Collectively we can make our community, which is already a great place, an even greater one."

The Lacroix Family has giving in their genes, and the next generation are carrying on the impressive philanthropic legacy started years ago by their grandparents.

"Our family has a history of entrepreneurship. The business opened in St. Albert in 1969 and continued to grow until it was sold in 2023. We just want to pay it forward," said Paul Lacroix, who along with his wife Marg have set up their own Foundation to support local charities.

Paul and Marg's Foundation is a big supporter of charities in the community, among them the St. Albert Food Bank and St. Albert Special Olympics. And the Sturgeon Hospital Foundation is at the forefront: "The Sturgeon Hospital has taken very good care of our family over the years" said Marg. She goes on to recount a few moving stories of lives saved and changed at the Sturgeon over the years, starting with their daughter, and other family members, including Paul himself last year.

Since setting up the fund Paul and Marg Lacroix have overseen the funding of life-saving equipment; including, most recently, two digital portable x-ray machines, which filled one of the hospital's greatest needs at this time.

They are known for funding leading-edge equipment, at times the first of its kind in the province, such as the PX Ultrasound Machine which positively changes the way breast cancer is diagnosed.

While still family owned, Pro-Western Plastics was a longtime champion of the Hospital; supporting the purchase of numerous pieces of equipment including a Hemodialysis Machine and a Transesophageal Echocardiogram, which impacts the care of ICU patients at the Sturgeon.

"My granddad and dad were team guys, and these donations were made as a team. You wouldn't believe what a good feeling it gave our employees. It became a big positive for everyone in the company."

And the Lacroix's agree that the one major benefit of setting up a legacy now as opposed to leaving it in their will, is that they have the advantage of being able to decide where the money can go.

"There were also practical considerations for setting it up when and how we did," said Paul. "I am intrigued by markets and figured that if we put it into the market then we can see how it grows. But most importantly, we get to see the benefits in real time! You don't get to see the benefits when you have passed on, but now we can react and do something about it. Once we are gone, others will decide."

Paul and Marg agreed to share their story of giving to hopefully inspire and encourage other people and families to think of things that are important to them right now and find ways to support them, right now.




GALA 2025

STANDARD GENERAL GOLF TOURNAMENT


Did we ever have fun on the course last month at the annual Standard General Tournament!
